Executive Director Mr. John Ware reported on the following:

- 1. <u>Transfer of Credit Update:</u> Earlier this week I participated in a stakeholders meeting to discuss the strategy plan being developed by the Department of Higher Education in accordance with Ohio Revised Code section 3333.166 that would enable students to transfer credits earned at for profit career colleges to state institutions of higher education. The Department of Higher Education will be holding several stakeholder meetings over the next few months to solicit input on the strategy plan that is required to be submitted to the legislature by January 1, 2019.
- 2. <u>Federal Update:</u> Last week the US Department of Education released the 2018 GE Disclosure Template. Institutions that participate in federal financial aid programs will have until April 6, 2018 to update disclosures for each of their Gainful Employment (GE) programs, using the 2018 GE Disclosure Template. Although the 2018 GE Disclosure Template is similar to last year's template, a number of modifications have been made. I would encourage all schools affected by GE regulations to vist the FSA web site and review the information that includes information about changes to the required GE disclosures and the process for submitting appeals on GE earnings data.
- 3. <u>Closed School Update:</u> The Board's staff is continuing to work with a number of schools that are in the process of closing through teach-outs including all the Brown-Mackie locations in Ohio, the Miami-Jacobs locations, Altierus Career College as well as Galliplis Career College that completed its teach-out last month. A few weeks ago it was announced that Vatterott College would be teaching out its location in Northeastern Ohio with the teach-out scheduled to conclude next fall.
- 4. <u>ACICS Update:</u> In December 2016, the US Department of Education issued it final decision denying the appeal of ACICS related to its status as a federally recognized accrediting agency. Thereafter, in accordance with federal regulations, ACICS accredited schools had 18 months to secure accreditation from a different federally recognized accrediting agency or they faced the prospect of the loss of federal financial aid funds. The 18 month time period ends on June 12, 2018. As you will recall, the Board suspended a number of its accreditation requirements during this 18 month time period as well. I will provide an update to the Board at the next meeting on the remaining ACICS accredited schools and their status transitioning to a new accrediting agency.
