**First Disciplinary Hearing:**

**CHAIR:** Good morning. My name is Kenneth Searfoss, Chair of the State Board of Career Colleges and Schools, and I will be presiding over this disciplinary hearing of this case on behalf of the State Board. At the conclusion of the evidence and after this Board has reviewed the evidence submitted this Board will take final action in this matter.

This is a matter with regard to the intent of the State Board of Career Colleges and Schools to initiate formal disciplinary action against Masters of Bartending. This hearing is taking place pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code. Since no formal hearing request was received from Masters of Bartending, the Board will only be reviewing evidence and documents presented by the Board's staff.

During the hearing, the testimony and offers of evidence shall be recorded by electronic means. The Board may administer oaths or affirmations.

To present the introductory exhibits I would like to present our representative from the office of the Attorney General, Mr. James Miller. Mr. Miller, Please enter for the record the identification of certain exhibits that establish compliance with Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**ATTORNEY GENERAL:** Thank you, Dr. Searfoss. I am presenting to the Board State exhibits 1 through 4. These exhibits include copies of the hearing notice and the original disciplinary resolution adopted by the Board as well as correspondence and other evidentiary information gathered by the Board's staff. I would ask that the Board admit these exhibits at the end of the hearing.

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**CHAIR:** Thank you. At this time, the Chair would like to call upon the Executive Director to identify the exhibits and provide testimony on the proposed disciplinary action. Mr. John Ware, Executive Director, is sworn in.

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR:** Thank you Mr. Chairman and the members of the Board. I will now evidence the exhibits. State Exhibit 1 is a copy of the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, including a copy of the disciplinary action adopted by the Board as well a copy of the certified mailing receipt; State Exhibit 2 is a copy of the application submitted by Mr. Robert Maguire identifying himself as one of the owners of the school and signed by Mr. Maguire; State Exhibit 3 is a copy of the Judgment Entry on Sentence for Mr. Maguire related to his criminal conviction; and State Exhibit 4 is a copy of the information pertaining to the criminal conviction showing the Mr. Maguire was convicted of pandering obscenity involving a minor (attempted) sexual motivation and he designated a sexually oriented offender. Those are the exhibits Mr. Chairman and pursuant to this Board's statutes the Board has the authority to discipline an individual or to deny them a license if they have signed an application for a certificate of registration and they have been convicted of a crime of moral turpitude. Based on the evidence I would submit that this is the case here.

**CHAIR:** Thank you Mr. Ware. Are there any other comments or statements by anyone at this particular hearing?

**CHAIR:** At this time, Mr. Miller, would you like to move for introduction of the exhibits?

**ATTORNEY GENERAL:** Yes, I would Dr. Searfoss. I would move the introduction of exhibits 1 through 4 which were identified by Mr. Ware during his testimony.

**CHAIR:** Are there any objections to the exhibits being admitted?

**CHAIR:** Hearing no objections, the exhibits are admitted. If there is no other testimony or exhibits, I declare this disciplinary hearing closed. I will now entertain a motion for a Board order on the proposed disciplinary action.

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**(15-082)Mr. Dennis Bartels moved** that the Board adopt the following adjudication order:

WHEREAS on July 23, 2014 this Board adopted a resolution proposing to deny the application for a certificate of registration and program authorization submitted by Masters of Bartending and/or the owner thereof and properly notified the school of their right to request a hearing; and  
WHEREAS no hearing was requested by the aforementioned school or the owner thereof; and  
WHEREAS this Board held its own hearing on January 28, 2015 to review the charges and evidence supporting those charges; and

WHEREAS this Board find that Masters of Bartending submitted an application for a certificate of registration that was signed by a person convicted of a crime of moral turpitude; and

WHEREAS this constitutes a violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 3332.09©.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

This Board hereby denies the application for a certificate of registration and program authorization submitted by Masters of Bartending in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 3332.09 of the aforementioned violations.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Executive Director of this Board is directed to notify Masters of Bartending and the owner thereof, of this Board's order.

To present the introductory exhibits I would like to present our representative from the office of the Attorney General, Mr. James Miller. Mr. Miller, Please enter for the record the identification of certain exhibits that establish compliance with Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**ATTORNEY GENERAL:** Thank you, Dr. Searfoss. I am presenting to the Board State exhibits 1 through 2. These exhibits include copies of the hearing notice and the original disciplinary resolution adopted by the Board as well as correspondence and other evidentiary information gathered by the Board's staff. I would ask that the Board admit these exhibits at the end of the hearing.

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**CHAIR:** Thank you. At this time, the Chair would like to call upon the Executive Director to identify the exhibits and provide testimony on the proposed disciplinary action. Mr. John Ware, Executive Director, is sworn in.

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR:** Thank you Mr. Chairman and the members of the Board. I will now evidence the exhibits. Exhibit 1 is a copy of the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing as well as a copy of the signed certified mail receipt; Exhibit 2 is copies of correspondence sent to Barbizon-Midwest as well as an e-mail where the Board had attempted to resolve this issue by getting the school to submit the items that were outstanding from the schools' last renewal. The school never did respond. The school is not currently operating nor has it been operating for over a year now. The owner of these schools actually lived in North Carolina and they would hold classes periodically at the three Ohio locations. Barbizon is a little bit different because they have a corporate office and grant these owners franchises to run schools in certain areas. This individual lost his franchise. I did have a conversation with a new potential franchisee that has said they will probably be coming back into Ohio. So it probable at the March or May Board Meeting that we will get an application for a new school for Barbizon-Midwest under a different ownership. This school is closed at this point. Although they did submit an application for renewal, and it was approved by the Board, they never completed the items.

**CHAIR:** Thank you Mr. Ware. Are there any other comments or statements by anyone at this particular hearing?

**CHAIR:** At this time, Mr. Miller, would you like to move for introduction of the exhibits?

**ATTORNEY GENERAL:** Yes, I would Dr. Searfoss. I would move the introduction of exhibits 1 through 2 which were identified by Mr. Ware during his testimony.

**CHAIR:** Are there any objections to the exhibits being admitted?

**CHAIR:** Hearing no objections, the exhibits are admitted. If there is no other testimony or exhibits, I declare this disciplinary hearing closed. I will now entertain a motion for a Board order on the proposed disciplinary action.

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**(15-083)Mr. Kenneth Miller moved** that the Board adopt the following adjudication order:

WHEREAS on July 23, 2014 this Board adopted a resolution proposing to impose disciplinary action against Barbizon Midwest-Columbus, Barbizon Midwest-Dayton, and Barbizon Midwest-Cincinnati and/or the owner thereof and properly notified the schools of their right to request a hearing; and WHEREAS no hearing was requested by the aforementioned school or the owner thereof; and WHEREAS this Board held its own hearing on January 28, 2015 to review the charges and evidence supporting those charges; and

WHEREAS this Board find that Barbizon Midwest-Columbus, Barbizon Midwest-Dayton, and Barbizon Midwest-Cincinnati failed to complete the certificate of registration renewal process because they failed to submit fees and other items required as part of the certificate of registration renewal process; and

WHEREAS this constitutes a violation of Ohio Revised Code Sections 3332.05 and 3332.07.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

This Board hereby orders that the certificates of registration and program authorization held by Barbizon Midwest-Columbus, Barbizon Midwest-Dayton, and Barbizon Midwest-Cincinnati are hereby revoked in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 3332.09 for the aforementioned violations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Director of this Board is directed to notify Barbizon Midwest-Columbus, Barbizon Midwest-Dayton, and Barbizon Midwest-Cincinnati and the owner thereof, of this Board's order.
