INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS

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Executive Director Mr. John Ware reported on the following:

1. **New Board Members:** We have two new Board members that were recently appointed to our Board. Dr. Steve Gratz has been designated as the representative of the Superintendent of Public Instruction for the Ohio Department of Education and Mr. Shane DeGarmo has been designated as the representative of the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents. In addition, Mr. Ken Miller has been re-appointed to a five year term on the Board by Governor Kasich.
2. **State Authorization Reciprocity Agreement (SARA):** We have been participating in the ongoing discussions regarding state reciprocity for distance education programs and I recently attended the Midwest Higher Education Compact (MHEC) forum on SARA in Chicago along with 60 other representative for the 10 MHEC states. In addition to the ongoing national discussions, we are continuing to review the potential impact of SARA on this Board (including the potential loss of fee revenue) in anticipation of possible Ohio legislative changes related to SARA implementation that will likely be introduced in the legislature as part of the mid-year budget resolution.
3. **Director Training:** We have scheduled two dates for director training this year. The first director training seminar will be held on May 6th and the second will be held on October 22nd.
4. **Ethics Update:** All Board members should be receiving the Ethics Commission's annual financial disclosure statements in the mail soon and they must be filed with the Ethics Commission by April 15th.
5. **Human Trafficking Initiative:** In coordination with the Governor's office and the Ohio Human Trafficking Task Force, we will be disseminating information on our web site and directly to schools in a campaign to raise awareness of the issues involved in human trafficking.

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PUBLIC ADMINISTRATIVE RULE HEARING

CHAIR: Good morning. My name is Kenneth Searfoss, Chair of the State Board of Career Colleges and Schools. For incorporation into the record, I would request that the secretary call the roll.

CHAIR: The Chair finds that seven (7) of the seven (7) members answered the roll call; therefore, there is the necessary quorum. Let the record show that this rules hearing is called to order at 10:59 a.m. on January 29, 2014, in the Board Room (Room 2925) of the State Board of Career Colleges and Schools, 30 East Broad Street, Suite 2481, Columbus, OH 43215.

This hearing is conducted pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code for the purpose of amending thirteen (13) rules of the State Board of Career Colleges and Schools. Pursuant to Section 119.03 C) of the Ohio Revised Code, any person affected by the proposed action of the Board may appear and be heard and may present evidence in support or in opposition to the proposed rule changes. The Board will rule on the admissibility of evidence. Proffers of evidence may be accepted.

During the hearing, the testimony and offers of evidence shall be recorded by electronic means. The Board may administer oaths or affirmations.

To present the introductory exhibits I would like to present our representative from the office of the Attorney General, Ms. Mia Yaniko. Ms. Yaniko, please enter for the record the identification of certain exhibits that establish compliance with Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code.

ATTORNEY GENERAL: Thank you, Dr. Searfoss. I am presenting to the Board State exhibits 1 through 17. These exhibits include copies of the public hearing notice and the administrative rule changes filed with JCARR and the Governor's Office of the Common Sense Initiative. I would ask that the Board admit these exhibits at the end of the hearing.

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CHAIR: Thank you. At this time, the Chair would like to call upon the Executive Director to identify the exhibits and provide testimony on the proposed rule changes. Mr. John Ware, Executive Director, is sworn in.

Those are the exhibits. Briefly, these proposed changes were brought to the Board back in 2012. We held an Administrative Rule Review Committee Meeting consisting of Board Members, Consultants, and Staff to review the staff proposed changes. We brought the Committee recommendations to the Board in January 2013. They were originally filed with JCARR in February 2013. However, we were notified that a number of the rules were required go to through the CSI process. So we withdrew the rules in February or March of 2013. We then completed the CSI process and refiled the rules in December 2013. I am happy to answer any questions on the proposed rules.

CHAIR: Today we will entertain testimony either orally or in writing for or against the rules which are under consideration. We are requesting that all testimony be limited to no more than five minutes. If additional time is needed, we will consider a reasonable extension.

If you have written testimony, it is important that you provide a copy to the Board so that the testimony will be a part of the record; and if you wish, in the interest of time, you may just submit the written testimony without reading it into the record.

When you are called, please come forward, be sworn in, state any organization your represent here today, and present your testimony.

Do we have anyone here today who will be giving testimony?

CHAIR: Hearing no testimony, are there any other comments or statements by anyone at this particular hearing?

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BOARD MEMBER, MR. SHANE DEGARMO: Being new to this process, I am not sure of what is the appropriate protocol. I guess this is more of a matter of notification. On Exhibit 7, 3332-1-16 - Program Standards, on Page 3 under Section D (2), there has been some language added stating “All associate degrees awarded by Ohio schools approved by the Board shall be designated as “associate of applied science” or “associate of applied business” unless the associate degree program meets the requirements of section 3332-1-04(D) of the Administrative Code.” This is language that is currently in the Ohio Board of Regents Rule 4. I just want to make the Board aware that we are currently revising this rule and so the language that comes out of that revision may not align with what you have proposed in this rule change.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR: Mr. Chairman and members of the Board, thanks for that notification. I think that we will be revising this rule next year to address the externship issues. I will get with you, Mr. DeGarmo, to make sure that numerical numbering lines up with what your requirements go to. Just so the Board Members know, this issue comes up really addresses the fact that a number of schools have approached us about issuing an associate of science or an associate of business degree. It doesn't come up very often but the reason we put this in there is to clarify to the schools that we are only going to approve that terminology if they meet the requirements of the Board of Regents for that terminology. Every state is a little different on how they label a degree program. So I will get with Mr. DeGarmo just to make sure we are on the same page about that. I don't think we are going to get many schools that want to offer an associate of art or an associate of science because they are basically transfer degrees. There seems to be a little confusion though among schools because some states they use the term associate of science for everything it seems like. Ohio is pretty clear on the difference in what applied science or business is. Thank you and we will follow up on that.

CHAIR: At this time, Ms. Yaniko, would you like to move for introduction of the exhibits?

ATTORNEY GENERAL: Yes, I would Dr. Searfoss. I would move the introduction of exhibits 1 through 17 which were identified by Mr. Ware during his testimony.

CHAIR: Are there any objections to the exhibits being admitted?

CHAIR: Hearing no objections, the exhibits are admitted. If there is no other testimony or exhibits, I declare this public hearing closed. We wish to thank all of you for your participation in our hearing today. I will now entertain a motion for approval of the rules under review including any recommended changes.
